TENNANT CREEK

PR JEREMIAH MADIMADI

Greetings from us in Tennant Creek. Thank you for praying for God's work here. We want to thank those who have made time to call, message and visit us to give us words of encouragement and support. All of this mean a lot to us.

We feel that we have settled in already so we are focusing on ministry and the affairs of the church. God is doing wonderful things here in Tennant Creek. I truly believe if God can provide water and food for the Israelites in the wilderness and in the remote Sinai desert, He is able to pour out his spiritual water and food for the spiritually hungry and thirsty souls here in Tennant Creek.

So far, we have witnessed seven people give their lives to the Lord and a demon possessed young girl get delivered. Please join us in praying for these new converts and for more young men and women to turn to the Lord.

On Tuesday evenings from 6:30-8:00pm we have Bible study and prayer. We have 10 to 15 people attending this program. We have been studying the topic 'The Word of God' for a few Tuesdays now and people seem to be enjoying it.

On Wednesday evenings we were doing outreach at the Aboriginal camps but this program has paused as I am not able to drive at the moment. Please pray for me to get my driver's license soon so I can go to the camps for outreach.

On Thursday evenings from 6:30–8:00pm we hold a ladies meeting. Our ladies are having great fun as they sit around and share scriptures and testimonies to encourage each other.

On Friday evenings from 6:30–8:00pm we hold our youth night. About 15 to 20 teenagers and children come to our youth nights. Some of them are very small but we take them in and care for them. Our aim is to touch as many young people as we can with the gospel. Please pray that God will give us some creative ways to reach them. Pray for sister Ebony (our youth leader) who does a fantastic job organising our youth programs.

I was not able to pick anyone up for one of our youth nights in November so Delia and I decided to sit at church and see who might came. At 6:30pm 10 children made their own way to church and asked if youth was on. We decided to make them some food. While they were eating they said they wanted to change their lives and asked me to pray. I prayed and five of the older ones said the sinners prayer and gave their lives to the Lord. I gave them Bibles, some more food and sent them home. It was special seeing these kids praying to God for change.

After the closing prayer one Sunday evening, a man walked to the front and told me he wanted to give his life to God. I lead him to the Lord as his wife and others stood beside and witnessed.

Let us rise together in prayer and believe for God to move in a fresh and mighty way in our church and sweep through the township of Tennant Creek. Let us cry out and ask God to heal our land and set people free from evil (2 Chronicles 7:14).

During the second week of November I finished teaching a subject to students in Ghana by Zoom. I have been doing this on Monday mornings. It has been a blessing and an honour for me to be teaching. My thanks and appreciation to Pr Barry Silverback for asking me to teach in this school.

Our Wednesday night Missions Prayer and Bible Study has been going well and we concluded for the year on Wednesday 30th November for Christmas and New Year. We will recommence our Wednesday night program in January. We have been learning a lot and have also enjoyed some great fellowship along with praying and studying.

Our children's church has been doing well. Mandy Wright is doing a great job with the help of our teenagers. It is so good to see the young ones learning and growing in Jesus.

We had a miracle happen on Sunday 20th November at church. A lady who is the niece of one of our older congregation members walked into church and sat down next to him. She listened to the message preached by our guest speaker. He gave an altar call for people to recommit their lives to Jesus. This lady put up her hand and said the prayer of recommitment. Praise God. She also said she will be coming back and will bring her mother who used to come here many years ago. Glory to God for all He is doing in His time.

We had our Missions Fundraiser Yard Sale on Saturday 19th November. We sold second hand used items that people gave us. Despite the cold we raised USD\$136 for missions. We had congregation members Michael Mizell and Charlene Baker helping us sell the goods. Larry Lother bought us a breakfast treat and Kathleen Arisman and Vilmarie Wright gave us moral support.

I have been enjoying preaching to elderly people in an old people's home every second Friday a month.

I have also been going with a group of friends to a Christian rehabilitation place for drug and alcohol addicts. I have had two opportunities to preach and a number of opportunities to minister one on one. This has been almost every month since I started going with the group for the last four months.

One Saturday our family travelled to Spartanburg where I was invited to preach. After my sermon I gave an altar call and many came for prayer. Later at lunch with the pastor told me they hadn't been having altar calls in church since the pandemic began because people have been too scared to be close to one another. After my alter call the pastor said that they knew they needed to get back into doing alter calls. Amazing! I was ignorant of what was happening in that church but God knew. Glory to God.

We are all in good health and are doing well. I had a birthday in November. It was great that it fell on our day off. Jethro and Young Warwick continue to do their school online which continues to be a challenge for all of us. Please continue to pray for the boys' schooling.

It is a blessing to have the boys helping in the sound booth at the church Sunday services.

We had some great fun and family time travelling to Spartanburg and overnighting in a motel. It is much colder now so we are not getting out as much to do some fun things.

The boys and I went and helped a friend with a small project he needed help with for his mother. We lifted up a wooden walkway off the concrete area and put it on some plastic stands to keep it out of the water. We replaced some of the wooden decking.

Our friend reminded us that last time we went there we prayed for the Arthritis in his hands. He then showed me how his hands are now healing up after praying. Glory to God.

I am very proud of the students and all that they managed to achieve during my short period of teaching.

I particularly enjoyed my time outside the classroom, spending time with the students during our fellowship dinner at Ela Beach and around the property as we sat and told all kinds of stories. They are a great group and I believe they will do well in their futures as preschool teachers

When I wasn't with the preschool students I was attending programs with mum and dad and spending time with different people on the Bethel Centre property. It was so good seeing everyone again and catching up with them all
