TENNANT CREEK TRIP REPORT

It was a real joy for Kelly and I to visit our amazing mob at Tennant Creek Christian Family Church (TCCFC) recently. We arrived Friday 24th February after a flight from Adelaide to Alice Springs and a 525km drive at 130km per hour (legal speed limit).

It was wonderful to be greeted by the Madimadi family. It was great to have some time to fellowship with Pr Jeremiah, Delia and little Nellie Winnie. They are doing an excellent job in their new role at TCCFC.

They are both learning so much living in Tennant Creek and ministering cross culturally. They have been received very well by the leaders and folk in our church at Tennant Creek.

On Saturday morning Pr Jeremiah and myself were up early to get ready for the ladies' breakfast at the church that Kelly was speaking at. Pr Jeremiah was on driving and pick up duties and I was the chief cook.

It was a good morning and the ladies enjoyed the fellowship with Kelly and what she shared. However, I think they had more fun stirring me up and complaining about my cooking. Miriam was the ring leader.

On Saturday afternoon, Pr Jeremiah, Delia, Kelly and I spent our time cleaning at the church and completing yard work.

It was a very busy but enjoyable and satisfying day.

On Sunday we had our two services at 10:00am and at 6:30pm. TCCFC are also doing our '40 Days of Engaging with Jesus' sermon series. I spoke in the morning on the 'Sinful Woman' and in the evening service on the 'Woman in the Crowd'.

We had a good crowd of new folk during our Sunday evening service with four people giving their hearts to the Lord. We prayed for many people for various illnesses.

20 kids turned up on Sunday night and two dogs. Kelly and Delia were looking after the kids and the dogs and helping pray for people. They had to set up a last minute Sunday school program to accommodate all the kids. It was a wonderful evening service and a great day all round.

We returned to Alice Springs on Monday and then to Adelaide on Tuesday. We had a great weekend at TCCFC.

There is so much opportunity in Tennant Creek and the harvest is ready to see many Indigenous folk come to the Lord. Although we may lack human and financial resources to do more than what we are currently doing, wherever God guides He will ALWAYS provide. Let's continue to believe for His provision.

Pr Jeremiah and Delia ably assisted by our team at TCCFC are doing so well. Let us continue to pray and support our mob in Tennant Creek.
