

# TENNANT CREEK TRIP ARTICLE

Tess and I had a wonderful time in Tennant Creek. Thank you church and to the ACC Elders for the wonderful opportunity of us visiting the Tennant Creek Christian Family Church (TCCFC). It was Tess' first trip there and she had the time of her life!

Although we knew our schedule prior to going, we still didn't know what to expect. We left early morning on Thursday and arrived in Alice Springs mid-morning that day. After organising our car, we did some food shopping for the week before heading to Tennant Creek. Thanks to Pr Mike who suggested we stop for petrol at Ti Tree which is 300km away from our destination and the only petrol station between Alice Springs and Tennant Creek!

We were warmly welcomed by the Madimadis and what a catch up we had since we last saw them in March this year. It was also a wonderful time ministering at the women's meeting that night with the Indigenous ladies at church.

On Friday, we had a good time of fellowship and a solid time of sharing with Pr Jeremiah and Delia. We were told that our visit was timely and being encouraged by God's Word was exactly what they needed. We also went to Lake Mary Ann to breathe some fresh air and see this beautiful part of Tennant Creek. Pr Jeremiah also drove us to the three different camps later in the afternoon. People were everywhere and even kids were on the streets in groups just roaming aimlessly. Government housing where these people live are run down and need some TLC. We really sensed that need for people to hear the gospel.

Saturday was our prep day for the Sunday morning and evening services, but in the evening we set a time for an immigration info session and to meet some of the Filipino folk and a Sudanese guy who had some queries with their visas. The event was also attended by the key leaders of TCCFC. It was good to see Richard and Gay and also Andrew and Miriam (Indigenous couple) and have a bit of fellowship with them over a meal.

Sunday was the highlight of our trip with around 30 people who came, majority of whom were Indigenous. We had a great morning service. Tess shared during communion and I shared the message. Again, in the evening service, there were over 30 people in attendance. Tess and I shared the pulpit and towards the end of my message, we allocated a good time to pray for people. There about five people who gave their heart to Jesus!

We left Tennant Creek on Monday with so much to thank God for and the wonderful opportunity given to us to have this memorable experience. We stayed in Alice Springs overnight and caught an early morning flight back to Adelaide.

I remember hearing Pr Barry say, "Tell me and I may forget, show me and I may remember, involve me and I will understand."

We've heard so much about our work in Tennant Creek and the things that are happening there, but the only way to truly understand the place and the people is to go there and experience it first hand.

Our recent trip taught us to be appreciative of life and to have an ongoing concern for our ministry and the work in Tennant Creek. It is an experience of a lifetime that we would want to do again, given the opportunity.
