In August and September, I had the pleasure of joining Pr Mike, Kelly and Mikaela for a missions trip to the USA. We visited multiple places including Los Angeles, San Diego, Atlanta, various spots in North and South Carolina, and of course, Walhalla.

We ate a lot of food and saw a number of gorgeous places. We even managed to squeeze in a quick baseball game at Petco Park in San Diego that I was very excited about.

Pr Mike and Kelly were only with us for two and a bit weeks before they travelled back to Adelaide. When they left, Mikaela and I spent the remainder of our trip at Faith Center Church (FCC) in Walhalla, South Carolina.

Coming into the trip, I was not sure what to expect knowing a bulk of our stay was going to be in Walhalla, but boy were we in for a treat.

From afar, Walhalla may look like a small town in the middle of nowhere but Pr Mike and our family at FCC showed us so many beautiful gems in and around the town.

The scenery and drives are like no other - there were lakes and greenery everywhere. Tall tree forests that go on for acres, mountains with breathtaking views, and food so comforting that it often feels just like a home cooked meal most of the time. Spending a few weeks in just Walhalla, I got to really experience the culture they have down in the South. This culture and experience was so different to what I had experienced before. The pride each local holds for the town was quite encouraging.

I had such a blast experiencing a local college football game at Clemson University and the beautiful day trips we took to various spots in North Carolina and Georgia.

One of my jobs to tick off the list while I was in the USA was to capture some drone footage of the FCC property. The property they have is incredible and it took me a few days to capture all of the drone footage I needed because it was quite large.

It was during those moments where I felt such an overwhelming inspiration for what God has planned for the church in the near future.

FCC has already served a lot of people in the past with their ministries, but now I feel even more excited about how God will use the church to bless and inspire others in the years to come.

Having 'lived like a local' for a few weeks was an overall energising experience for me in many different areas. My heart has deeply grown a very special place for our congregation members at FCC and the town of Walhalla.

I am grateful for the people I met during my visit and for the new friends I have made. This was a trip I will treasure fondly and a place I encourage everyone to keep in your prayers and visit if the opportunity arises.
