On Saturday afternoon Pr Mike and I met with Edward and Josephine from Papua New Guinea. They were previously serving in the life of our church but they left Tennant Creek some time ago.

They have since returned with their daughter Esther and Pr Mike was happy for them to start helping in the church programs once again.

On Saturday evening, we had a wonderful dinner fellowship with all of the key church members.

Pr Mike spoke in our morning service on the Sunday and Kelly shared in our evening service. At the end of our evening service during prayer ministry, Pr Mike asked people to raise their hands if they wanted prayer for salvation. Nine kids raised their hands and Pr Mike led them to the Lord.

Please pray for these kids who received salvation and join us in believing for more children to give their lives to God.

ELLIOT OUTREACH

I am excited to inform you that when Pr Mike was here, he asked Edward and Josephine to help run fortnightly services in the town of Elliot.

We will also clean and set up an old caravan on the church property for them to stay in when they are in Elliot.

Some families from Elliot are already aware of what we are planning to do and they are happy. I have announced it to our church members and have encouraged them to get involved and support our outreach efforts. We are hoping to reach out to Elliot and some small towns and communities in the Barkley region and up to Katherine.
