GLOBAL TRAINERS CONFERENCE

At the beginning of September, Pr Neil Milne, Pr Mike Groom and Kelly Groom were in Papua New Guinea (PNG) for the Global Trainers Conference. The event was hosted at Bethel Christian Centre (BCC) in Port Moresby. Pr Neil was the guest speaker and Pr Mike also had a couple of opportunites to share.

The conference was attended by pastors, staff and students of Bethel International Training College, our ministry training base located on the BCC property. A pastor from the Philippines and staff members of CRC ministry training schools around PNG also travelled to Port Moresby to be part of the event.

The conference ran over three days and it was held in our new training building. Three classrooms were used by the delegates. Pr Neil and Pr Mike shared from one classroom and the remaining two classrooms broadcast the teaching live via Zoom. Positive feedback was received by the delegates.

Throughout their visit, Pr Neil, Pr Mike and Kelly all had opportunities to minister into the lives of Bethel Tabernacle of Praise's (BTOP) congregation members. BTOP is the church operating under BCC.

Pr Neil shared in the men's fellowship meeting, and in both Sunday morning services - Pidgin and English. Pr Mike shared in the Sunday evening service. Kelly ministered in the ladies' meeting.





MISSIONS FUNDRAISING DINNER

Saturday 16th November

Bethel Christian Centre is located in Port Moresby, Papua New Guinea (PNG). The land was secured in the early 1970s by Pr Barry Silverback. It has since grown into a large and strong Apostolic base.

From this base, workers have been trained and sent across PNG and into countries around the world. Under the leadership of Pr Barry, CRC bases and churches have been established in the Solomon Islands, Fiji, Vanuatu, the Philippines, Sri Lanka, India and beyond. Many of our key CRC workers in these nations received their ministry training at Bethel Christian Centre.

Today we face the challenge of updating facilities that are in need of maintenance and expansion. One of the most important facilities in need is our bathroom and laundry block.

Currently, the ladies' bathroom consists of two toilets and two showers. The men's bathroom consists of six showers and two toilets. Approximately 70 individuals are using these facilities on a regular basis. This increases during events and other occasions when people come to stay on the property.

Plans are in place to relocate a 40-foot shipping container from one corner of the carpark area to a space right next to the existing bathroom block. This will be converted into a toilet block – four toilets for females and four for males

The space is almost ready for the container to be moved. The existing bathroom block will undergo renovations, which will see six showers for females and six showers for males, as well as two toilets for each.

In addition to this, the existing missions office will be transformed into an accessible bathroom for Gabi Wari. Gabi is the wife of one of our pastors, Pr Ai Wari. She suffered a stroke some years ago which has significantly restricted her physically. It is a necessity to provide access to an accessible bathroom to cater to her needs.

In order to do this, the finance office has undergone extensions so there is enough space to relocate our missions office there. This has created space for an accessible bathroom to be constructed in the current missions office, which is next door to Pr Ai and Gabi's house. The bathroom will be ready for Aunty Gabi in October.

Next month across our churches, we will be raising funds to assist with these vital upgrades at Bethel Christian Centre. One of our fundraising initiatives is a Missions Fundraising Dinner being held at Adelaice Christian Centre on Saturday 16th November. Further details will be released soon so keep an eye and ear out.
